

Larisa Dunai is an Associate Professor at the Universitat Politècnica de València. She began her academic career there in 2008, earned her PhD in 2010, and was accredited as Associate Professor in 2013. She meets the criteria for Full Professor accreditation and holds a recognized research period (sexenio).

Her research focuses on assistive technologies for the visually impaired, leading to the development of See4Me, a navigation and reading aid that competes with projects by Google and Sony.

Her work has received prestigious innovation awards from institutions in Spain, the US, the EU, and the UK, including the MIT Technology Review Innovator of the Year (2013) and the IET Innovation Award (2014), as well as the Michael Richey Medal from the Royal Institute of Navigation.

Since 2020, she has served as Chair of the Technical Committee on Education in the IEEE Industrial Electronics Society.
